

Rosh Hashanah Activities

Handprint Greeting Cards (Courtesy of URJ Website)



Ages 3-8

Materials

Construction paper
Pencils
Scissors
Crayons
Glue stick
Sparkly stickers, glitter

Directions:

Fold construction paper in half.

Trace your child's hand onto the paper, putting their pinky against the folded edge. Cut along the traced line.

Add a New Year's greeting inside the card and have your child decorate the card with stickers and glitter.



Rosh Hashanah Activities

Make an Apple into a Honey Bowl- Hold a Honey Tasting (Courtesy of URJ Website)



Materials:

A washed apple
Lemon juice
Honey
Paring knife.

Directions:

Have an adult remove the core of the apple and hollow out the sides, being careful not to cut through the sides or bottom.

Rub lemon juice on the cut inside to keep it from turning brown.

Fill the apple with honey and place it in the center of a plate. Surround your apple honey dish with lemon juice sprinkled apple slices for dipping. Enjoy!

Honey Tasting

Set out dishes of different varieties of honey, like clover, poplar, wildflower, blueberry and orange blossom.

Have apples and Challah pieces ready for dipping.

After sampling, let everyone pick their favorite. For a fun family activity, do a graphing project by making a graph of the results.
